

Getting it Write: A Handwriting Class

Getting it Write is a special handwriting program designed for children experiencing difficulties with the skill of handwriting.

The program improves the child's perception of letter formation through fun sensory activities, and visual and verbal instruction.

This unique program was developed by and is taught by an occupational therapist. Each week focuses on a different underlying skill that precedes the development of handwriting. A multi-sensory approach to handwriting is emphasized, including general body coordination, tactile and kinesthetic awareness, visual spatial perception, hand manipulation skill, strength and motor planning.
